- To encourage enrolling in career orientation programs that would empower and equip them with the necessary skills to choose career options.


**Roles and Responsibilities**

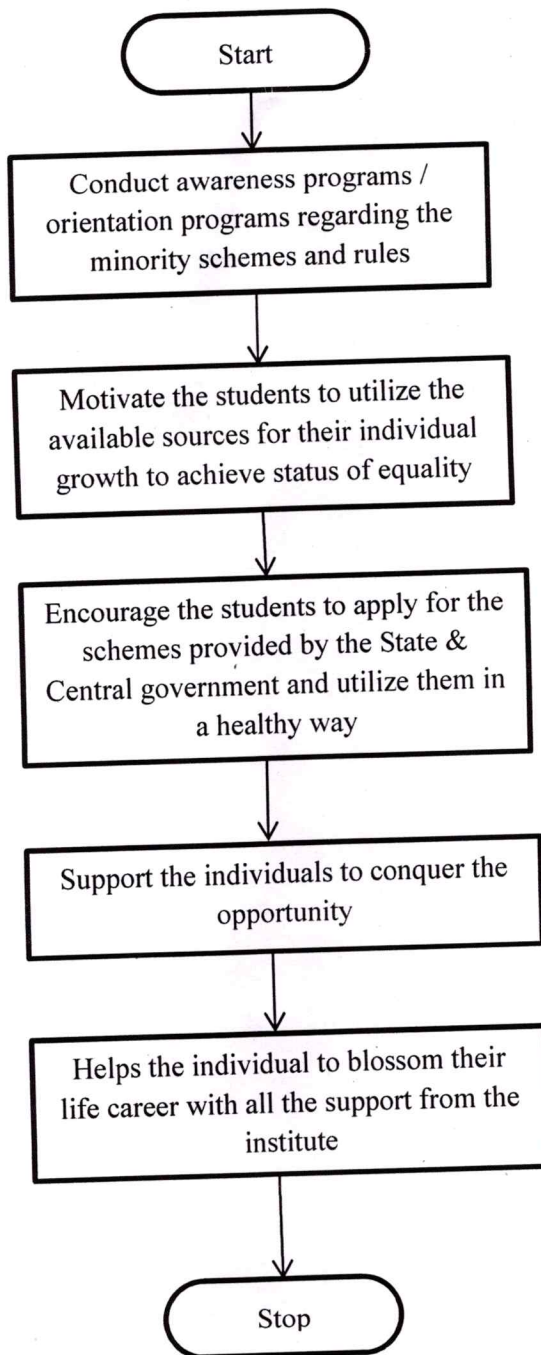

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
